

July Festival FAQ

Registration

Q

How do I register for the festival?

A

Festival vendors and food trucks use the same registration form. Forms are available at the Finance and Utilities Building or can be downloaded and printed from our website.

Payment

Q

How do I pay the festival registration fee?

A

Payment can be made in person at 126 South Fayetteville Street, Liberty, NC 27298. You may also mail your completed form and payment to PO Box 1006, Liberty, NC 27298

Setup

Q

When will I receive vendor or food truck setup information?

A

Vendors and food trucks will be contacted the Monday of festival week with setup details. You will receive your vendor number and instructions for entering the festival area. Staff will be on site to assist with placement.

Departure

Q

Can vendors or food trucks leave during the festival?

A

No. For safety reasons, the road remains fully closed during the event. Vendors and food trucks must stay for the duration of the festival.

Emergencies

Q

What should I do in case of an emergency?

A

Call 911 immediately. You may also notify event staff, and we will contact law enforcement if needed.

Weather

Q

Is there a rain date?

A

No. The festival will be held rain or shine

Utilities

Q

Is power or water provided for vendors and food trucks?

A

No, power and water are not provided. If you require power, you must bring your own generator. Generators must be quiet and not disturb other vendors. If a generator is disruptive, you may be asked to turn it off.

Parking

Q

Where can attendees, vendors, and food trucks park?

A

Public parking is available throughout downtown, including areas behind the showcase and the Finance and Utilities Building. Parking is not permitted within the festival road closure area.
